The following guidelines for responsible maintenance will help secure your investment in your Conklin Roofing System and provide optimum performance.

- 1. Regular inspections, at least twice a year, are crucial for maintaining the condition of your Conklin Roofing System. It is best to inspect in fall and spring following the thermal extremes of summer and winter. This proactive approach helps identify potential issues early, preventing costly repairs.
- 2. Inspecting your roof is crucial After extreme weather conditions, such as heavy rains, high winds, hail, nearby fires, or explosions. This immediate assessment helps to identify any potential damage and take immediate action.
- 3. Clear any debris or contaminants regularly, including unclogging drains.
- 4. Keep a record of maintenance and visitors to the roof.
- 5. Keep a file of all records related to the inspections and activity related to your roof.
- 6. Inspect after service has been performed on any equipment on the roof.
- 7. Do not allow unauthorized personnel access to your roof.
- 8. Do not permit equipment service personnel to penetrate or alter your roof. An approved roofing contractor must handle these.
